5-Year Programme:



Is recruited into the Trust as an apprentice



Is employed on an **Apprenticeship Agreement**

Entry Requirements:

- A minimum of 112 UCAS points (equivalent to 3 A Levels) one subject must be in a science.
- 5 GCSEs these must include Maths and English at Grade 4 or above.
- Prior work experience is **not** essential

2, 3 and 4-Year Programmes:



 Is an existing employee who is recruited onto the RNDA programme



 They remain employed as a Band 3/Band 4 member of staff

Entry Requirements:

- At Least a Level 3 qualification in a health-related subject OR 3 A Levels (1 of these must be in a health-related subject or a science).
- PLUS Maths and English at GCSE grade C/Grade 4 or above, or equivalent (e.g. Level 2 Functional Skills)
- At least 12-months of permanent employment in a clinical support role (Band 3 at least).

Similarities:



 They are enrolled onto the RNDA with the University of Sunderland & will study in campus and in the workplace



Upon successful completion, they are awarded a BSc (Hons) level 6
 qualification



 Upon successful completion, they will qualify for registered status as a Mental Health or Learning Disability nurse with the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC).



Similarities (Continued):



The University programme was devised in partnership with CNTW



• The student will benefit from learning tailored to the workplace.



CNTW will use the Apprenticeship Levy to meet all training costs



 CNTW will gain a qualified nurse with a BSc (Hons) degree and with current Nursing skills



 They will learn alongside other undergraduate nursing students, and develop and enhance the knowledge, skills and values required to meet the Future Nurse: Standards of Proficiency for Registered Nurses (Nursing and Midwifery Council 2018)



 They will have a work-based mentor, a Trust-assigned Education Support Nurse (ESN) and an AESIP (Apprentice Educator Supervisor in Practice) from the University.



They have placements as well as a base ward where they will stretch their competencies



 The ESN and Student ensure regular reviews take place within the workplace and University
